Н	High Risk: The hazard must be removed/avoided or the level of risk significantly reduced by reliable controls.
Μ	Medium Risk: The hazard should be avoided or the level of risk reduced by implementing reliable controls.
L	Low Risk: May be controlled by the use of instruction, training and supervision and/or personal protective
	equipment
Ι	Insignificant Risk: Controlled by good working practices

Revised Risk Level is determined by reconsidering the hazards in the controlled environment, to establish that the level of risk has been eliminated or at least reduced.
